



### **Advanced Placement**

2018-2019 - 33 students took 50 exams with 70% scoring a 3 or better; 12% earned AP Scholar Award

2017-2018 - 23 students took 51 exams with 71% scoring a 3 or better, 22% earned AP Scholar Award

2016-2017 – 32 students took 59 exams with 84% scoring a 3 or better; 25% earned AP Scholar Award

2015-2016 – 34 students took 56 exams with 82% scoring a 3 or better; 18% earned AP Scholar Award

2014-2015 – 36 students took 65 exams with 79% scoring a 3 or better; 31% earned AP Scholar Award

**To participate in the Honors Program**, a student must meet all graduation requirements, take six out of the sixteen honors classes in the proper sequence **AND** maintain **a grade greater than or equal to 80% in EACH honors class**. The honors program includes the following classes: College Prep English 1, College Prep English 2, Advanced Placement English, Spanish 3, Spanish 4, Algebra 3, Pre-Calculus, Advanced Placement Calculus AB, Advanced Placement Calculus BC, Physics, Advanced Placement Biology, Anatomy/Physiology, Chemistry, College Prep Government, Advanced Placement U. S. History, and Advanced Placement World History. For Advanced Placement classes, students will receive an additional 1.0 grade for As, Bs, and Cs when determining their 4.0-scale GPA.
