In order to keep all senior portraits uniform, we ask that your portraits adhere to the specifications below.

2019-20 Seniors are to choose TWO photos. One must be a “professional looking” portrait and the second is student choice. However both need to follow the guidelines below. Photos must be submitted to Jennifer Walsh at [jwalsh@pcsdk12.org](mailto:jwalsh@pcsdk12.org) or Room 116 at the high school. The deadline for **graduating seniors** is **December 1, 2019**. The deadline for **all other seniors** is **January 21, 2020**.

Photos must be submitted by email or on a CD saved as a jpeg file. Please make the file as high of quality as possible.(Prints will be accepted, but to ensure the highest quality, digital copies are **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED**.)

- Variety of photographs
- Avoid filters that cover face (Snapchat filters)

Close-up shots are **STRONGLY DISCOURAGED** because of cropping problems.

Backgrounds should be simple and uncluttered.

**The yearbook staff reserves the right to return any unacceptable pictures if they do not meet the above specifications.**
